An Invitation to Participate in The Sisters Library Annual Art Exhibit 2020

- Art Exhibit dates: **Wednesday, January 8th** through **Friday, February 28th**.
- Artwork submission: **Saturday, January 4th**, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Sisters Library Community Room. Artwork must be left for the entire length of the show.
- Opening reception with hors d'oeuvres and beverages: **Friday evening, January 24th**, at the Sisters Library from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- Three '**People's Choice Awards**' will be **presented at the reception**. Voting from **January 8th through January 24th**.
- Artwork pickup: **Friday, February 28th** from 1:00 p.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Only artwork that has not been exhibited in the Annual Art Exhibit in the past three years will be accepted.** All artwork submitted must be approved by the Friends of the Sisters Library Art Committee. No nudes will be accepted.
- Due to limited space, only two pieces of wall hung art may be submitted. Secured wire hangers are required for all artwork that will be hung; no saw tooth hangers. Wall-hung art cannot exceed 30" X 40" unless space permits.

Quilts and other Fiber Art **MUST** have a sleeve secured on the back for hanging. Larger quilts to be hung on the rafters cannot exceed 84" wide X 75" long.

- **Two pieces of either sculpture or ceramics no larger than 12" may be submitted. Five pieces of jewelry, boxes, baskets, etc may be submitted. These artwork pieces will be placed in the locked display case in the entryway. There will be no tables or shelves for display of larger pieces.**
- Please print and identify each piece of artwork with the attached label found at the bottom of this email. Attach either on the back or bottom of the artwork.
- A signed [Art Exhibit Agreement](#) is required to submit your work. The Deschutes Public Library System will insure your work during the period that it is in the library building.
- Please bring a one-page biography that includes your name, a description of your submitted work and your contact information. These pages will be kept in a binder in the library that accompanies the show.
- The Friends of the Sisters Library shall receive a **twenty** percent commission from the artist for any artwork sold during the art exhibit.


